THE M42 MOTORWAY
(JUNCTION 3) (SLIPS)
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has revoked an existing Order and made a new Order on the M42 Motorway, in the Counties of Worcestershire and Warwickshire, because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a 50 mile per hour speed restriction on –

- (a) the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3, from a point 180 metres west of its junction with the M42 Junction 3 Roundabout, to that roundabout;
- (b) the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3, from its junction with the M42 Junction 3 Roundabout, to a point 30 metres east of that roundabout;
- (c) the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3, from a point 112 metres east of its junction with the M42 Junction 3 Roundabout, to that roundabout; and
 (d) the entry slip road leading to the
- (d) the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3, from its junction with the M42 Junction 3 Roundabout, to a point 34 metres west of that roundabout.

The Order will come into force on 24 May 2021 and have a maximum duration of 18 months.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and the second s

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance and special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions.
