ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

NEW ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new domestic gas service.

Order Commences: 26 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 29 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Alcester Road, Church Street and vice versa.

PRATTS LANE, MAPPLEBOROUGH GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Birmingham Road (from a point outside Quietways).

Reason for Order: To enable essential utility works.

Order Commences: 27 April 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 29 April 2021.

Access & Diversion: Birmingham Road, Pratts Lane and vice versa.

PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY AL201 IN THE PARISH OF ALCESTER

Order Effect: Bridleway closed to ALL traffic between grid references SP 08126-57672 (point A) and SP08031-57744 (point B).

Reason for Order: To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the dangerous condition of a bridge along its route.

Order Commences: 22 April 2021 for up to 6 months.

Access & Diversion: Cold Comfort Lane, Roman Way, AL49, AL80, Cold Comfort Lane and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
