

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984-SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M42 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 3) (EASTBOUND EXIT SLIP ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited has made an Order on the M42 Motorway in the County of Worcestershire, to enable electronic traffic detector installation works to be carried out. The effect of the order will be to close the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3.

The work will be carried out over one night between 21.00 hours and 06.00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 6 December 2021. The Order will come into force on 29 November 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the work or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via the M40 and the A3400 will be signed.
