ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

MILL LANE, OVERSLEY GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for repairs to a water pipe.

Order Commences: 8 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 December 2021.

NEW ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Alcester Road and Church Street.

Reason for Order: To enable utility works.

Order Commences: 6 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 December 2021.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Church Street, Alcester Road and vice versa.

NEW ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Westmead Avenue to a point adjacent to the electricity sub-station.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the connection of foul and surface water sewers.

Order Commences: 6 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 December 2021.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Alcester Road, Church Street and vice versa.

Contractor: Erris Builders Ltd, Tel: 07967 610 143.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
