

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D5211 SAMBOURNE LANE/WIKE LANE, COUGHTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with A435 Birmingham Road and The Green.

Reason for Order: Drainage investigation and associated works, 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

Order Commences: 7 February 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: Due to unforeseen circumstances the works cannot commence as originally planned and have been rescheduled for 21-25 February 2022.

Access & Diversion: Middletown Lane, Bromsgrove Road, A435 (Haydon Way, Birmingham Road) and vice versa.

D5470 STEPPES PIECE, BIDFORD ON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic in its entirety from its junction with Victoria Road.

Reason for Order: Footway reconstruction and associated works, 08.00hrs-17.00hrs weekdays only.

Order Commences: 7 February 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 24 February 2022.

Access & Diversion: There is no available diversion route.

NEW ROAD, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Alcester Road to Apple Tree Cottage.

Reason for Order: To enable works to install a new gas main.

Order Commences: 7 February 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 4 March 2022.

Access & Diversion: Alcester Road, Church Street, New Road and vice versa.

COUGHTON FIELDS LANE, COUGHTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with B4089 and A435 Birmingham Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new clean water connection.

Order Commences: 21 February 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 23 February 2022.

Access & Diversion: Coughton Fields Lane, Captains Hill, Kinwarton Road, Kinwarton Farm Road, Tything Road West, Arden Road, Birmingham Road and vice versa.

TEMPLE GRAFTON ROAD, ARDENS GRAFTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of new underground electricity cables.

Order Commences: 19 February 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 27 February 2022.

Access & Diversion: Temple Grafton Road, Bidford Road, Wixford Road, Evesham Road, Windmill Hill, New Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A435 STUDLEY COUGHTON AND ALCESTER) (RESTRICTED ROAD REVOCATION, 40MPH & 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, COUGHTON) (30 & 40MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THE TRUNK ROAD (A435/A46) (ALCESTER BYPASS) (40 MPH AND DE-RESTRICTION) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THE A435 TRUNK ROAD) (GORCOTT HILL TO STUDLEY, WARWICKSHIRE) (RESTRICTION AND 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council has made the abovenamed Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which:

- removes the Restricted Road status by Order on the lengths of road described in Schedule 1 below, as those lengths of road have become a restricted road by virtue of a system of street lighting now in place thereon;
- imposes a 40mph speed limit on the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 2, below; and
- imposes a 50mph speed limit on the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 3 below.

The Order commences on Monday, 7th February 2022.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

(30 MPH by virtue of a system of street lighting)

A435 Birmingham Road

The length of the A435 Trunk Road between points 285 metres and 406 metres southwest of its junction with the centreline of Icknield Street Drive.

A435 Birmingham-Evesham Road, Studley/Sambourne

From the Southern side of its junction with Toms Town Lane in the Parish of Studley, to the northern side of its junction with the A448 Studley-Bromsgrove Road at Sernal Ash in the Parish of Sambourne, a distance of approximately 846 metres.

A3400 Birmingham Road, Stratford

From the centre of One Elm Bridge over the Stratford upon Avon Canal, north westwards to a point 195 metres southeast of its junction with the A46 (Warwick to Evesham Road), a distance of approximately 1.58 kilometres.

A3400 Shipston Road, Stratford

From a point 91 metres south of its junction with Banbury Road (A422), to its junction with Shipston Road roundabout, a distance of 950 metres.

B4035 Campden Road, Shipston

From a point 82 metres south-west of its junction with Darlingscote Road in a generally westerly direction to a point 73 metres west of its junction with Sadlers Avenue, a distance of approximately 466 metres.

A435 Alcester Road/A435 Birmingham Road

From a point 37 metres south of its junction with Sernal lane, northwards for a distance of 138 metres.

A448 Bromsgrove Road, Studley

From its junction with the A435 Alcester Road/A435 Birmingham Road, north westwards for a distance of 42 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

40 MPH

A435 Birmingham Road – Coughton-Alcester

From a point 683 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Coughton Fields Lane to a point 194 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Ragley Mill Lane; including the roundabout junction with the B4090 Alcester Heath Road and B4089 Kinwarton Link Road, known locally as the Birmingham Road Roundabout; a distance of 2960 metres.

A435/A46 Alcester Bypass

The A435 in a north-easterly direction from a point 150 metres south-west of the centre point of its roundabout junction with the B4090 Alcester Heath Road and B4089 Kinwarton Link Road.

SCHEDULE 3

50 MPH

A435 Alcester Road/Sernal Ash/Haydon Way Birmingham Road

From a point 36 metres south of the centreline of its junction with Sernal Lane to a point 683 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Coughton Fields Lane; a distance of 1260 metres.
