

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

WARWICK HIGHWAY, MAPPLEBOROUGH GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic outside the new care home (High House Farm).

Reason for Order: To enable Section 278 highway improvement/access works.

Order Commences: 3 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 21 May 2022.

Access & Diversion: Warwick Highway, Icknield St. Drive, Birmingham Road.

HIGH STREET, BIDFORD ON AVON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Honeybourne Road to Saxonfields. The Bus Lane Only Restriction and Prohibited Right Turn will be temporarily suspended while works are in progress.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new water connection.

Order Commences: 4 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 6 May 2022.

Access & Diversion: Honeybourne Road, Tower Hill, High Street and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CHURCH STREET, STUDLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with New Road and Manse Gardens.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the laying of new gas services.

Order Commences: 16 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 20 May 2022.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Toms Town Lane, Alcester Road, Church Street and vice versa.

PROPOSED SPEED CUSHIONS AND TRAFFIC

CALMING MEASURES

Warwickshire County Council proposes to install:

- 5 no. sets of speed cushions pursuant to Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, upon those lengths of road as described in Schedule 1 below; and
- A traffic calming measure (a build out) pursuant to Section 90G of the Highways Act 1980, upon those lengths of road as described in Schedule 2 below.

- Set 2 – located opposite property No 20 School Road – Each Cushion 1.70m (width) x 3m (length) x 0.075m (height)
- Set 3 – located. 10m south east of the north west facing flank wall of the Primary School, on School Road – Each Cushion 1.70m (width) x 3m (length) x 0.075m (height)
- Set 4 – located 99.5m south east of the north west facing flank wall of the Primary School, School Road – Each Cushion 1.70m (width) x 3m (length) x 0.075m (height)
- Set 5 – located 104m north west of the centre line of Ban Brook Road – Each Cushion 1.60m (width) x 3m (length) x 0.075m (height)
