

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) AND (7) THE M42 MCTORWAY (BETWEEN JUNCTION 2 AND JUNCTION 3) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the M42 Motorway, in the Counties of Worcestershire and Warwickshire, to enable maintenance works to be carried out by National Grid.

The effect of the Order will be to close –

- the eastbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3;
- (2) the westbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 3, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2;
- (3) the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3, and
- (4) the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 2.

The closures are expected to be in place for one night starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 31 July 2023 and ending at 06:00 hours on Tuesday 1 August 2023. The Order will come into force on 24 July 2023.

Order will come into force on 24 July 2023. Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or vehicles being used in connection with the work will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the A441, the A4023, the A435 and vice versa will be signed.
