ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

MILL LANE, BROOM

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable tree cutting works and installation of CBT's between poles.

Order Commences: 5 February 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 6 February 2024.

Access & Diversion: Bidford Road, High Street, Mill Lane and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

COUGHTON FIELDS LANE, ALCESTER

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To safely enable hydrant chamber rebuild.

Order Commences: 20 February 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 22 February 2024.

Access & Diversion: Coughton Fields Lane, Birmingham Road, Willoughby Close, Arden Road, Tything Road West, Kinwarton Farm Road, Kinwarton Road, Captains Hill and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
