## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14**

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOFT LANE, DUNCHURCH**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Toft Lane, Dunchurch, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate BT ducting works. The Order will commence on 14 December 2015 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 December 2015.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3351 HOSKYN CLOSE, RUGBY**

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3351 Hoskyn Close, Rugby at a point outside property number 47, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a small main repair. The Order will commence on 14 December 2015 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 December 2015.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

### **(WILLOUGHBY, GRANDBOROUGH AND SAWBRIDGE, RUGBY) (PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OF OVER 7.5 TONNES) ORDER 2015**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of goods vehicles of over 7.5 tonnes in maximum gross weight in the length of road described in the Schedule below.

The usual exemptions for loading/unloading, emergency services, local authority and statutory undertakers' vehicles will apply.

The Order commences on 14 December 2015.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Evreux Way, Rugby, CV21 2RR and at the Dunchurch Community Library, The Green, Dunchurch, Rugby, Warwickshire, CV22 6PA during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### **SCHEDULE**

##### **Willoughby, Grandborough, and Sawbridge, Rugby**

- i) from its junction with the Daventry Road (A45) to its junction with Woolscott Road for its entire length (Main Street (Willoughby), Moor Lane, Sawbridge Lane, Main Street (Grandborough), Grandborough Road)
- ii) Lower Street, Willoughby – from its junction with Main Street, Willoughby to its junction with Woolscott Road for its entire length.
- iii) Woolscott Road – from its junction with the Daventry Road (A45) to its junction with the Daventry Road (A45) for its entire length.
