ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C30 HILLMORTON LANE (THE KENT) RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C30 Hillmorton Lane (The Kent) Rugby for a distance of approximately 20 metres either side of the railway bridge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a safety examination of the railway bridge.

The Order will commence on 26 January 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, the examination work will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 14.30hrs with anticipation that the works will be completed on that day, 26 January 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: D3241 Lower Hillmorton Road, B5414 Whitehall Road, C213 Clifton Road, C213 Vicarage Hill, C213 Rugby Road, C213 Main Street, C29 Lilbourne Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C28 BRETTFORD ROAD, KING'S NEWNHAM

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C28 Bretford Road, King's Newnham from the junction with Kings Newnham Lane to Newnham Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway patching.

The Order will commence on 8 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: B4455 Fosse Way, Kings Newnham Lane and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3182 CHURCH WALK, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3182 Church Walk, Rugby, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a water service cut off.

The Order will commence on 12 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 12 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
