## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2034 BOW LANE & KIRBY LANE, WHITHYBROOK

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2034 Bow Lane, from the junction with Kirby Lane to B4455 Fosse Way and Kirby Lane from its junction with Main Street to Bow Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway patching.

The Order will commence on 17 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Main Street, Rugby Road, B4455 Fosse Way and vice versa.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A426 LAWFORD ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing A426 Lawford Road, Rugby between the junctions of Plowman Street and Oliver Street, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a long comm pipe installation.

The Order will commence on 13 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 14 February 2016.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3310 MOORS LANE, RUGBY

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2182 CHURCH HILL, STRETTON ON DUNSMORE

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3013 MAIN STREET, LONG LAWFORD

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3013 Main Street, Long Lawford at the junction of Baileys Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate the rebuild of a hydrant chamber.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3181 LITTLE CHURCH STREET, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3181 Little Church Street, Rugby at a point opposite the property number 12B, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required to facilitate repair to a burst water main.

The Order commenced on 16 January 2016 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier.
