ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FLECKNOE STATION ROAD & SCHOOL HILL, WOLFHAMPCOTE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Flecknoe Station Road & School Hill, Wolfhampcote, Rugby, from the junction with Sawbridge Road to the junction of Vicarage Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of ducting.

The Order will commence on 25 November 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 December 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Sawbridge Road, Main Street, Park Hill, Daventry Road, Flecknoe Road, School Hill (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2063 COSFORD ROAD ROUNDABOUT, BROWNSOVER, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2063 Cosford Road Roundabout, Brownsover, Rugby, from the junction with X29910 Valley Drive to the junction with D31200 Valley Drive, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 5 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 December 2016.

Please Note: The work will be carried out overnight between 19.00hrs and 07.00hrs each night until completion.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Cosford Lane, Brownsover Road, Valley Drive and vice versa.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BLOXAM GARDENS & SEABROKE AVENUE, NEW BILTON, RUGBY) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2016

Warwickshire County Council have made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to impose a 20 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 25 November 2016.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Evreux Way, Rugby and at the Public Library, Little Elborow Street, Rugby, CV21 3BZ during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
