TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2063 COSFORD ROAD ROUNDABOUT, BROWNSOVER, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2063 Cosford Road Roundabout, Brownsover, Rugby, from the junction with X29910 Valley Drive to the junction with D31200 Valley Drive, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 5 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 December 2016.

Please Note: The work will be carried out overnight between 19.00hrs and 07.00hrs each night until completion.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GRANDBOROUGH FIELDS ROAD, GRANDBOROUGH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Grandborough Fields Road, Grandborough, from the junction of Broadwell Road to the junction of Aikman Green, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for a new electricity supply.
