

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3585 BEECH DRIVE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3585 Beech Drive, Rugby to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2268 HOSPITAL LANE & D2265 GIBRALTAR LANE, BROADWELL, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2268 Hospital Lane, from the junction with A426 Southam Road to the junction with Main Street, and D2265 Gibraltar Lane, from the junction with Hospital Lane to Merlin Field Farm, to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2063 COSFORD ROAD ROUNDABOUT, BROWNSOVER, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2063 Cosford Road Roundabout, Brownsover, Rugby, from the junction with X29910 Valley Drive to the junction with D31200 Valley Drive, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order commenced on 5 December 2016 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. Unfortunately the works, as advertised in the Rugby Observer, had to be deferred but have now been rescheduled to take place 10th, 11th, 17th & 18th February 2017.

Please note: The work will be carried out overnight between 19.00hrs and 07.00hrs each night until completion.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Cosford Lane, Brownsover Road, Valley Drive and vice versa.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 (PART OF FOOTPATH R20Y WOLVEY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

On 31 January 2017 Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to DIVERT that section of Public Footpath R20Y commence near Wolds Lane at Point A (grid ref 44325 28783) running generally south south east for approximately 585 metres to Point B (grid ref 44379 28763) as shown on the Order Plan TO A LINE From Point A (grid ref 44325 28783) running generally east for approximately 75 metres to Point C (grid ref 44340 28784), then south east and south south east for approximately 550 metres to Point D (grid reference 44379 28769) then generally south for approximately 30 metres to Point B (grid reference 44379 28763) as shown on the Order Plan. The new route shall have a width of 2 metres, except the first 50 metres from Point A which shall have a width of 3 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Warwickshire County Council, Shire Hall, Market Square, Warwick CV34 4SA from 8am - 5.30pm on weekdays, (5pm Fridays) and 9am - 4pm Saturdays. The Order comes into force on 7 February 2017, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 2 February 2017, make an application to the High Court.
