

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SMEATON LANE, RUGBY**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Smeaton Lane, Rugby to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a new electricity supply.

The Order will commence on 27 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lutterworth Road, The Crescent, Broad Street, Coventry Road, Shilton Road, Ansty Road, Ansty Lane, Smeaton Lane (and vice versa).
