

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAWSTON ROUNDABOUT AND COVENTRY ROAD, CAWSTON

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Cawston Roundabout and Coventry Road, Cawston, from a point 40 metres east of Cawston Roundabout to a point approximately 150 metres west of the roundabout, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required for carriageway surfacing works.

The Order commenced on 21 January 2017 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. Due to unforeseen circumstances the works were delayed but have now been rescheduled to commence 20 February 2017 with anticipation of completion of those works on or before 24 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Coventry Road, Rugby Western Relief Road, Lawford Road, Warwick Street, Dunchurch Road, Russelsheim Way, Bilton Road, The Green, Main Street (and vice versa).

Please note: There will be no access to the roundabout from Cawston Grange Drive and Calvestone Road.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3585 BEECH DRIVE, RUGBY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2280 WOOLSCOTT ROAD & C74 LONGDOWN LANE, WILLOUGHBY, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2280 Woolscott Road & C74 Longdown Lane, Willoughby, Rugby, as indicated in the schedule below, to vehicular traffic.

Woolscott Road from the junction with Brooks Close to A45 Daventry Road

Longdown Lane From the junction with A45 Daventry Road to the County Boundary

The closures are required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 22 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 February 2017.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2268 HOSPITAL LANE & D2265 GIBRALTAR LANE, BROADWELL, RUGBY

Alternative routes are available and will be appropriately signed.
