

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, WILLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Main Street, Willey from the A5 to the County Boundary, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate drainage maintenance works.

The Order will commence on 3 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Main Street, Coal Pit Lane, A5 Jct A4303/B4027 Roundabout, Watling Street, A5 from end of dualling north of Willey To Jct A4303/b4027 Roundabout, A5 from start of dualling north of Willey to end of dualling south of Claybrooke Parva Nw (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SMEATON LANE, RUGBY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3247 ST PETERS ROAD, RUGBY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2272 FLECKNOE ROAD, LEAMINGTON HASTINGS, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2272 Flecknoe Road, Leamington Hastings, Rugby, from the junction with A426 Southam Road to the junction with Hayway Lane, to vehicular traffic.
