

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C172 BRETTFORD ROAD, KINGS NEWNHAM, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C172 Bretford Road, Kings Newnham, Rugby from the junction with B4455 Fosse Way to the junction with Kings Newnham Lane, to vehicular traffic.
