ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LOWER STREET/MOORS LANE, HILLMORTON, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Lower Street/Moors Lane, Hillmorton, Rugby to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for road & footpath realignment and drainage services construction.

The Order will commence on 15 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lower Street, Watts Lane, Crick Road, Moors Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROADWELL ROAD, GRANDBOROUGH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Broadwell Road, Grandborough from a point adjacent to Paddocks View to a point approximately 655 metres from Grandborough Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate duct laying works.

The Order will commence on 25 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Broadwell Road, Grandborough Fields Road, Hill Road, Grandborough Road, Southam Road, Flecknoe Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HEATH LANE, BRINKLOW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Heath Lane, Brinklow from a point approximately 160 metres past Longacre, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a hydrant.

The Order will commence on 26 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 July 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B4642 BILTON ROAD, THE GREEN, MAIN STREET, COVENTRY ROAD AND D3495 THE GREEN SERVICE ROAD, BILTON, RUGBY.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing B4642 Bilton Road, The Green, Main Street, Coventry Road and D3495 The Green Service Road, Bilton, Rugby, from the junction of Plexfield Road to the junction at Calvestone roundabout, to vehicular traffic.

The closures are required for carriageway resurfacing work.

Please note: Access to and egress from the following roads will be affected as the bellmouth of each road will be resurfaced from their junction with B4642 into each road for a distance of approximately 20 metres: C88 Alwyn Road, C88 Lawford Lane, D3497 Magnet Lane, D3496 Bawnmore Road, D6831 Ivy Grange, D3492 Church Walk, D3585 Beech Drive

The Order will commence on 22 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. The work will be carried out in three phases with anticipation of completion by 8 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

Alternative routes will be appropriately signed.

TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT – SURFACE DRESSING 2017 SPEED RESTRICTIONS – RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 10 mph on the roads as indicated in the schedule below.

The temporary speed limit is required for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 25 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 July 2017.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OLD LEICESTER ROAD, RUGBY) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below.

Old Leicester Road

That length of road from its junction with the A426 Leicester Road in a northerly direction to a point 26 metres south of the British Waterways 1990 Oxford Canal Bridge Structure.
