

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -SECTION 14(1)(a) THE A45 TRUNK ROAD (TOLLBAR END TO RUGBY, WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF

TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Highways England Company Limited
(Company No. 9346363) intends to make
an Order on the A45 Trunk Road, in the
County of Warwickshire to allow road
markings and road stud replacement
works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to

- (1) close, at different times –
 (a) the eastbound carriageway of the
 A45 from its junction with the slip
 - A45 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A423, near Tollbar End, to its junction with the A4071, at Rugby;
 - (b) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the B4553, at Rugby, to its junction with the slip road leading from the A423, near Tollbar End; and
 - near Tollbar End; and
 (c) the laybys adjacent to the lengths
 of A45 described in (a) and (b)
 above: and
- above; and
 (2) prohibit any vehicle from entering
 or leaving the lengths of the A45
 described in (1)(a) and (b) above, at its
 junction with any side road.

The work will be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 25 September 2017 and continue for eleven nights. The Order will come into force on 18 September 2017.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures and prohibitions. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Diversion routes via the A423, the A426 and the B4429, and vice versa; via the A46, The A452, Baricote Road, Westhill Road and the A445, and vice versa; and via the A4071, the B4453 and the A423 and vice versa will be signed.
