

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –
SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1-2,
WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY
RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION
OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow resurfacing and additional maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to, at different times –

1. impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on –
 - (i) the northbound carriageway of the M6, from a point 300 metres east of the tip of the nosing at its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to the centreline of the eastern underbridge of the roundabout at Junction 1; and
 - (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M6, from a point 300 metres northwest of the tip of the nosing at its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to the centreline of the eastern underbridge of the roundabout at Junction 2;
2. close –
 - (i) the northbound carriageway of the M6, from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2; and
 - (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M6, from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 1;
 - (iii) the slip road leading –
 - (a) to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 1; and
 - (b) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Sunday 17 September 2017 and continue for 12 weeks. The Order will come into force on 11 September 2017.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction and closures. Vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction. Vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the M69 Junction 1, the A5 and the A426 and vice versa will be signed.
