ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (TUCKEYS CANAL BRIDGE, CATHIRON LANE, HARBOROUGH MAGNA) (10 TONNES WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to impose a 10 tonne maximum gross weight restriction on that length of Cathiron Lane, Harborough Magna which is carried by the bridge (known as Tuckeys Bridge) over the Oxford canal. A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan
