ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LOWER STREET & MOORS LANE, HILLMORTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Lower Street & Moors Lane, Hillmorton from the junction with Constable Road to the far side of the bridge outside Normandy Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate gas main diversion works.

The Order will commence on 27 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lower Street, Watts Lane, Crick Road, Moors Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MOORS LANE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Moors Lane, Rugby from the junction of Constable Road to the junction with Crick Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to excavate carriageway and install a new water main.

The Order will commence on 27 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Moors Lane, Lower Street, Watts Lane, Crick Road (and vice versa).

Notice of holding of an Inquiry regarding an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to the Warwickshire County Council by Ms Sally Chant, on behalf of a residents' group known as 'SHARE – Sustainable Hillside and Rokeby Education of Rugby' under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulation 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green at least 20 years prior to the date of the Application by virtue of use as of right for lawful sports and pastimes by a significant number of the inhabitants of the neighbourhood

A public inquiry will take place to consider this Application between Monday 18th November 2017 and Tuesday 19th November 2017 and will be held at The Arnold House, Rugby Masonic Centre, Church Walk, Elsee Road, Rugby, CV21 3BA commencing at 10 am on each day. There will be an evening session (to hear evidence from those people who cannot attend during the daytime) to take place between 6pm and 9:30pm on 18th November 2017.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.
