

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2164 CHURCH LANE, THURLASTON, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2164 Church Lane, Thurlaston, Rugby from its junction with Main Street to its end, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 23 February 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 23 February 2018, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HILL ROAD, GRANDBOROUGH

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Hill Road, Grandborough from a point opposite Springfield Farm to the junction with Grandborough Fields Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of concrete chambers.

The Order will commence on 9 February 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 February 2018.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FLECKNOE STATION ROAD, WOLFHAMPCOTE
