

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3362 CHARTER ROAD, RUGBY
&
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2073 COLLEDGE CLOSE,
BRINKLOW, RUGBY**

Warwickshire County Council has made Temporary Traffic Orders closing the roads as indicated below, to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3059 BROWNSOVER LANE, RUGBY

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2174 DRAYCOTE ROAD,
BOURTON ON DUNSMORE, RUGBY**
