

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2164 CHURCH LANE, THURLASTON, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2164 Church Lane, Thurlaston, Rugby from its junction with Main Street to its end, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FLECKNOE STATION ROAD, WOLFHAMPCOTE
