

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DEANE ROAD, HILLMORTON, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Deane Road, Hillmorton, Rugby from a point outside property number 35 to a point outside property number 34, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of ducts in the carriageway and footway.

The Order will commence on 8 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COALPIT LANE, WOLSTON

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3248 SLADE ROAD, RUGBY

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (VARIATION D) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Rugby and at the Public Library, Little Elbow Street, Rugby during usual opening hours.
