## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2172 MAIN STREET, BOURTON ON DUNSMORE, RUGBY**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2172 Main Street, Bourton on Dunsmore, Rugby from the junction with Straight Mile to the junction with Draycote Road to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 12 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Bourton Lane, Birdingbury Road, Frankton Road, Main Street, Marton Road, Birdingbury Road, A423 Oxford Road, B4453 Rugby Road, B4453 Princethorpe Road and vice versa.

Please note: This diversion is only suitable for vehicles under 13 ft 3 in in height due to low bridges on Birdingbury Road (13'3") and Marton Road (15'3").

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2172 BOURTON LANE, BOURTON ON DUNSMORE, RUGBY**

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MOORS LANE, HILLMORTON**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Moors Lane, Hillmorton, from Lower Street before railway bridge (Hillmorton Side) to the Farm entrance on the Corner of Moors Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate excavation works for the laying of new ducting for cables.

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STRETTON ROAD, STRETTON ON DUNSMORE**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Stretton Road, Stretton on Dunsmore, from its junction with A45 London Road for a distance of approximately 150 metres in a northerly direction, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a safe environment for engineer to work in an underground structure.

The Order will commence on 9 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 April 2018.

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A426 LEICESTER ROAD, RUGBY**
