ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT – RUGBY – SURFACE DRESSING 2018 – SPEED RESTRICTIONS

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 10 mph on the roads as indicated in the table below.

The temporary speed limit is required for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway. The Order will commence on 1 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 September 2018.

Please note: The speed restriction will only be imposed whilst convoy work for surface dressing is being carried out to each road – advance signage will be in place as appropriate.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2195 SHEEP DIP LANE, PRINCETHORPE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2195 Sheep Dip Lane, Princethorpe, Rugby from its junction with A423 Oxford Road to the junction with B4455 Fosse Way, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the construction of a new footway.

The Order will commence on 16 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: B4455 Fosseyway, B4453 Rugby Road, A423 Oxford Road.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B4429 COVENTRY ROAD, DUNCHURCH, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing B4429 Coventry Road, Dunchurch, Rugby from the junction with A45/M45 Roundabout to Medda Place Market Garden to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate drainage survey works.

The Order will commence on 5 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. The works will be carried out overnight between 20.00hrs to 06.00hrs with anticipation of completion by 06.00hrs on 8 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: B4429 Coventry Road, A426 Rugby Road, A426 Dunchurch Road, A426 Rugby Gyratory, A426 Corporation Street, A426 Newbold Road, A4071 Newbold Road, A4071 Parkfield Road, A4071 Rugby Western Relief Road, A45 London Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MONTGOMERY DRIVE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Montgomery Drive, Rugby at the north end of the cul-de-sac from the entrance to Admirals Court, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 19 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 May 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NORTH ROAD, CLIFTON UPON DUNSMORE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing North Road, Clifton upon Dunsmore from a point outside property number 2, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for a hydrant rebuild.

The Order will commence on 4 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: North Road, Main Street, Church Street (and vice versa).
