ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D3108 MILL ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D3108 Mill Road, Rugby from its junction with Railway Terrace to its junction with Technology Drive, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for street lighting installation works.

The Order will commence on 20 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between overnight between 22.30hrs and 02.00hrs on 21 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Mill Road, Butlers Leap, Clifton Road, Murray Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COPSTON LANE, COPSTON MAGNA

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Copston Lane, Copston Magna from the junction with Green Lane to the junction with Cloudesley Bush Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a power duct.

The Order will commence on 8 May 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 May 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Copston Lane, Cloudesley Bush Lane, Lutterworth Road, Smockington Lane, A5 from jct B4114 west of Smockington to start of dualling south of Smockington, Watling Street, A5 from start of dualling south of Smockington to jct B4455 Se, Coventry Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROCKHURST LANE, MONKS KIRBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Brockhurst Lane, Monks Kirby from a point outside property number 18, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate the installation of a hydrant for the Fire Service.

The Order will commence on 8 May 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 May 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Brockhurst Lane, Sandy Lane, Monks Kirby Lane, Bond End (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GIBBET LANE, SHAWELL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Gibbet Lane, Shawell from the junction of the Gibbet Lane roundabout to a point opposite Gibbet House, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate a safe environment for engineers working on underground cabling structure.

The Order will commence on 23 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 April 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The work will be carried out overnight between 21.00hrs and 06.00hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Gibbet Lane, A5 from jct A426 roundabout to start of dualling north of M6, A5 jct A426 Roundabout (and vice versa).

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (VARIATION D) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018

Warwickshire County Council have made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 20 April 2018.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Rugby and at the Public Library, Little Elborow Street, Rugby during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from date of the making of the Order apply to the High court for this purpose.

i. East side from a point 43 metres north of its junction with Wells Street, northwards for 6.6 metres

i. East side from a point 86 metres south of its junction with Abbey Street, southwards for 6.6 metres

Grosvenor Road – Disabled Badge Holders Only

i. East side from a point 11 metres South of its junction with Wells Street, southwards for 6.6 metres

Oxford Street – Disabled Badge Holders Only

i. East side from a point 10 metres South of its junction with Cross Street, southwards for 6.6 metres

Rugby Cattle Market – Revocation of No Waiting at any Time

i. East side from a point 10 metres North of its junction with Craven Road, northwards for its entire length

ii. West side from a point 10 metres North of its junction with Craven Road, northwards for its entire length
