

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF YATES AVENUE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Yates Avenue, Rugby from a point outside property number 67 to the junction of Foster Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of Grasscrete blocks and bollards.

The Order will commence on 26 October 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 November 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: the works will be carried out between 08.00hrs and 17.00hrs Monday to Friday only.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Yates Avenue, Foster Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RATCLIFFE ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Ratcliffe Road, Rugby to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate essential drainage works.

The Order will commence on 20 October 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 November 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAWFORD ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Lawford Road, Rugby, from its junction with Corporation Street to its junction with Vicarage Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for drainage investigation and repair.

The Order will commence on 29 October 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 2 November 2018. Works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30 hrs.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO ACCESS from A426 in to Lawford Road. A temporary One Way system will be in operation in Lawford Road. However, egress from Lawford Lane on to the A426 will be unaffected.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Corporation Street, island off Evreux Way, Oliver Street, Lawford Road (ONE WAY ONLY).

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KITEBROOK ROAD, BARTON ON THE HILL

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRINKLOW ROAD, MAIN STREET, RUGBY ROAD & CORD LANE, EASENHALL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Brinklow Road, Main Street, Rugby Road & Cord Lane, Easenhall, from the junction of Rugby Road and Cathiron Lane to the Junction of Cord Lane and Rugby Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closures are required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 31 October 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 9.30hrs and 15.30 on 31 October 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of roads to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

PLEASE NOTE: Access from and egress to The Rickyard and Farm Lane may be disrupted whilst works are in progress.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Rugby Rd, Broad St, The Crescent, Lutterworth Rd, Main St, Stretton Rd, Coventry Rd, Rugby Rd, Pailton Rd, Easenhall Rd, Rugby Rd, Cord Lane and vice versa.
