ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PAILTON ROAD & RUGBY ROAD, HARBOROUGH MAGNA

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Pailton Road & Rugby Road, Harborough Magna from the junction of Easenhall Road and Rugby Road to the junction of Pailton Road and Back Lane, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 19 November 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 November 2018.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: B4112 Rugby Road, B4112 Harborough Road, B4112 Main Street, B4112 Newbold Road, A4071 Newbold Road, A426 Leicester Road, A5 Watling Street, B4428 Lutterworth Road, B4112 Rugby Road and vice versa.

The closure is required to safely facilitate footway reconstruction works.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAY LANE, RUGBY

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PART OF FOOTPATHS R268 AND R268A GRANDBOROUGH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

On 30 October 2018 Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will DIVERT R268 commencing on the drive to Caldecote Farm at Point A (Grid Reference 44718 26485), running generally north northeast for approximately 375 metres to Point B (Grid Reference 44739 26517) TO A LINE from Point A running generally east northeast for approximately 236 metres to Point C (Grid Reference 44739 26495), then generally north for approximately 84 metres to Point D (Grid Reference 44736 26503) then approximately 136 metres to Point B (Grid Reference 44739 26517) as shown on the Order Plan. The new route shall have a width of 3 metres between Points A-C-D and 2 metres between Points D-B and also DIVERT R268a commencing on the drive to Caldecote Farm at Point E (Grid Reference 44722 26491) running generally east for approximately 274 metres to Point F (Grid Reference 44750 26494) TO A LINE from Point C (Grid Reference 44739 26495) running generally east for approximately 105 metres to Point F as shown on the Order Plan. The new route shall have a width of 2 metres.

The Order comes into force on 7 November 2018 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 1 November 2018 make an application to the High Court.
