ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH R250 IN THE PARISHES OF WILLOUGHBY & WOLFAMCOTE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath R250 in the Parishes of Willoughby & Wolfamcote to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the dilapidated and dangerous condition of a bridge along its route.

The Order will commence on 10 November 2018 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Moor Lane, Willoughby Road and Wolfamcote Lane.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FREEBOARD LANE, STRETTON ON DUNSMORE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Freeboard Lane, Stretton on Dunsmore to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate utility works in the footway, verge and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 29 November 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 December 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Freeboard Lane, London Road, A45 from Jct B4455 to Jct A445 W, A45 Jct A445 roundabout, A45 from Jct A45 to J A423 W, A423 Jct A45 join Nw, Oxford Road, A423 jct A45 join including two way section Se, A423 Jct A45 roundabout, Stonebridge Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAY LANE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing May Lane, Rugby from a point outside property number 22 across the carriageway to a point outside property number 15, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate utility works in the footway and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 28 November 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 November 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: May Lane, Bilton Road, Addison Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KITEBROOK ROAD, BARTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Kitebrook Road, Barton on the Hill to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate the installation of a duct.

The Order will commence on 9 November 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 November 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Little Compton Road, Kitebrook Road (and vice versa).
