ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FISHER AVENUE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Fisher Avenue, Rugby from the junction of Ashlawn Road to a point outside property number 72, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works.

The Order will commence on 2 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Fisher Avenue, St Johns Avenue, Hillmorton Road, Ashlawn Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GRANDBOROUGH ROAD, GRANDBOROUGH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Grandborough Road, Grandborough from a point outside Long Orchard, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water plots.

The Order will commence on 2 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Grandborough Road, Willoughby Road, Woolscott Road, London Road, Main Street, Moor Lane, Sawbridge Road and vice versa.
