

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LONG FURLONG, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Long Furlong, Rugby, from a point outside property number 69, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate excavation works for the connection of new plots water supply onto the mains.

The Order will commence on 14 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BACK LANE, HARBOUGH MAGNA

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (VARIATION 2) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below.

The Order commences on 14 January 2019.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Rugby; and at the Public Library, Little Elbowe Street, Rugby during usual opening hours.
