

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRINDLEY ROAD, HILLMORTON, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Brindley Road, Hillmorton, Rugby from points either side of the railway bridge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate essential repair works to the railway bridge

**PLEASE NOTE:** The works will be carried out overnight between 22.00hrs and 06.00hrs on weekday nights and 22.00hrs and 10.00hrs at the weekends.

The Order will commence on 11 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BADBY LEYS, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Badby Leys, Rugby, from its junction with Orson Leys to its junction with Fawsley Leys, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required to facilitate drainage works

The Order commenced on 17 September 2018 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. Due to unforeseen circumstances the contractor was unable to complete the work as planned. However, the work has now been rescheduled to recommence 4 February 2019 with anticipated completion by 15 February 2019.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The works will be carried out between 08.00hrs and 17.00hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A428 CRICK ROAD, HIGH STREET & ASHLAWN ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing A428 Crick Road, High Street & Ashlawn Road, Rugby, from the junction with A428 Hillmorton Road to the junction with A5 Watling Street, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching and associated works.

The Order will commence on 13 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 February 2019.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The work will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BACK LANE, HARBOUGH MAGNA

## (A426 DUNCHURCH ROAD, RUGBY) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to revoke the 40mph speed limit and impose a 30mph speed limit, by virtue of street lighting, on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below.
