ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FROBISHER ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Frobisher Road, Rugby from its junction with Lawford Lane to the junction with Freemantle Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing and associated works

The Order will commence on 18 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 February 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.00hrs and 15.30hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lawford Lane, Main Street, B4642 Bilton Road, Addison Road, Blackwood Avenue, Freemantle Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALEXANDRA ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Alexandra Road, Rugby, from a point outside property number 2, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 6 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 6 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Alexandra Road, Manor Road, Kimberley Road, Wood Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH CONISTON ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing the Public Footpath Coniston Road, Rugby to all traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works.

The Order will commence on 4 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 March 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: The closure of the footpath will be carried out in phases until completion.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Hawlands, Coniston Close (and vice versa).
