

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BIGGIN HALL LANE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Biggin Hall Lane, Rugby, from Broadgate to Honeywood, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 March 2019.
