ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BAWNMORE ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Bawnmore Road, Rugby, from the junction with Dunchurch Road and Overslade Road, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate carriageway surfacing works and the installation of traffic calming measures.

PLEASE NOTE: Access to and egress from Bawnmore Park and Edyvean Close may be affected while works are in progress.

The Order will commence on 18 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3rd May 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Overslade Road, Shakespeare Gardens, Dunchurch Road.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FLECKNOE STATION ROAD, WOLFHAMPCOTE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Flecknoe Station Road, Wolfhampcote at the junction with Sawbridge Road, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 23 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 April 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Flecknoe Station Road, Broadwell Road, Grandborough Fields Road, Hill Road, Sawbridge Road, Grandborough Road, Willoughby Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH R129 IN THE PARISH OF LONG LAWFORD

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath R129 in the Parish of Long Lawford, between Grid References 447126.275594 and 447222.275787, to all traffic. The closure was required to avoid danger to persons using the path, or preventing the likelihood of such danger, arising from nearby development works.

The Order commenced on 22 October 2016 and was due to expire on 22 April 2019. However, The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has now directed that the Order should continue in force until the works to which it relates have been completed or until 31 July 2019, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State extends the Order by a further direction).

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: A428 Coventry Road, The Green, Railway Street, and Back Lane.
