

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A426 DUNCHURCH ROAD, RUGBY) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to revoke the 40mph speed limit and impose a 30mph speed limit, by virtue of street lighting, on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 10 May 2019.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Rugby; and at the Public Library, Little Elborow Street, Rugby, during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on grounds that any requirement of the that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

A426 DUNCHURCH ROAD, RUGBY – 30 MPH LIMIT

From a point 36.5 metres south of its junction with Overslade Lane southwards for 40 metres.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (VARIATION E) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2019 AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ASHLAWN ROAD, RUGBY) (SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2019

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (i) impose a 40 mph speed limit upon that length of Ashlawn Road which is described in Schedule 1 below; and
- (ii) vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 2 below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in Schedule 2 below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the proposed Orders, together with a copies of Orders to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and statements of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at Rugby Borough Council, Town Hall, Rugby and at the Library & Information Centre, Little Elborow Street, Rugby during usual opening hours.

SCHEDULE 1

(Proposed 40mph Speed Limit)

Ashlawn Road, Rugby

From a point 729 metres south-west of its junction with Fareham Avenue, south-westwards to its roundabout junction with Dunchurch Road (being an approximate distance of 2295 metres).

SCHEDULE 2

(Proposed No Waiting at Any Time)

Ashlawn Road, Rugby

Both sides, from a point 50 metres south-west of the stop line on the north-eastern approach, to a point 50 metres north-east of the stop line on the south-western approach.

Barby Road, Rugby

Both sides, from a point 50 metres north-west of the stop line on the south-eastern approach, south-eastwards to its junction with Ashlawn Road.

Onley Lane, Rugby

Both sides, from a point 50 metres south-east of the stop line on the north-western approach, north-westwards to its junction with Ashlawn Road.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCHOVER LANE, HARBOROUGH MAGNA

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Churchover Lane, Harborough Magna, from the junction with Montilo Lane to the junction south to the ford on the River Swift, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely fix signs to the bridge parapets and associated works.

The Order will commence on 30 May 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs on 30 May 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Hospital Lane, Harborough Magna Road, The Green, School Street, Lutterworth Road, A426, A5, Lutterworth Road, Montilo Lane and vice versa.
