ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILLERS LANE, MONKS KIRBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Millers Lane, Monks Kirby to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for works to replace a defective manhole cover and frame.

The Order will commence on 7 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Fosse Way, Bell Lane, Street Ashton Lane, Millers Lane, Main Street, Withybrook Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BUTLERS LEAP, CLIFTON ROAD & VICARAGE HILL, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Butlers Leap, Clifton Road & Vicarage Hill, Rugby to vehicular traffic as indicated in the table below.

The closures are required for the construction of new signalised junction.

The Order will commence on 8 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTIONS 90A AND 90G EDWARD STREET, RUGBY – PROPOSED CHICANES

Warwickshire County Council propose, under sections 90A and 90G of the Highways Act 1980, to install one Priority give-way chicane and two speed humps on Edward Street, Rugby, as described in more detail in the Schedule below.

Edward Street

Location 1

Proposed installation of one Priority give-way chicane outside of no.40 between George Street and York Street measuring approximately 1.5 metres (length) x 3.9 metres (width) x 0.2555 (height).

SCHEDULE 2 (Location of Speed Humps)

Edward Street

Proposed installation of two speed humps measuring approximately 6.6 metres (length) x 3.7 metres (width) x 0.075 metres (height) on Edward Street Rugby at the locations listed below:

Location 1

Outside of Seabroke House between Victoria Avenue and Rowland Street.

Location 2

Outside no.1 Edward Street
