

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BUTLERS LEAP, CLIFTON ROAD & VICARAGE HILL, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Butlers Leap, Clifton Road & Vicarage Hill, Rugby to vehicular traffic as indicated in the table below.

The closures are required for the construction of new signalised junction.

The Order will commence on 8 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MELLOR ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Mellor Road, Rugby between properties number 10 and 16, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for utility works.

The Order will commence on 3 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 July 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Packwood Avenue, Browning Road, Mellor Road (and vice versa).

### TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT – B4642 COVENTRY ROAD, CAWSTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 30 mph on the above named road, between its junctions with Alwyn Road and Cawston Grange Drive roundabout.

The temporary 30mph speed limit is required for the safety of all road users and of contractors working on or near to the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 15 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 November 2019.
