

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984-SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the M6 Motorway, at Rugby, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow bridge inspection works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the southbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 1; The work will be carried out over one night between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Thursday 27 June 2019. The Order will come into force on 24 June 2019.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closure. ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M1 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 18) (SLIP ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M1 Motorway, in the County of Northamptonshire, to allow street lighting repairs to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 18.

The work will be carried out over one night between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 24 June 2019. The Order will come into force on 21 June 2019.
