

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALFRED GREEN CLOSE, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Alfred Green Close, Rugby to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for the installation of a hydrant.

The Order will commence on 7 August 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROWNING ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Browning Road, Rugby from a point outside property number 50, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for a boundary box and meter installation.

The Order will commence on 7 August 2009 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Myers Road, Packwood Avenue, Browning Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BARR LANE, BRINKLOW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Barr Lane, Brinklow from its junction with Broad Street, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for structural patching of carriageway & associated works.

The Order will commence on 4 August 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 08.00hrs and 16.00hrs on 4 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FLECKNOE STATION ROAD, WOLFHAMPCOTE
