

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LITTLE LAWFORD ROAD, LITTLE LAWFORD

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Little Lawford Road, Little Lawford, from a point outside SILOAM to a point opposite Little Park House, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate the building of a chamber and the installation of cables.

The Order will commence on 21 October 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 November 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE DINGLES, FRANKTON

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A4071 STRAIGHT MILE (BLUE BOAR FLYOVER) BOURTON-ON-DUNSMORE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing A4071 Straight Mile (Blue Boar Flyover) Bourton-on-Dunsmore to vehicular traffic from the junctions with the Rugby Road and the Straight Mile between the surface change east of garden centre entrance and the eastbound exit and entry slip roads of the A45.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAWFORD LANE, RUGBY
