

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

COSFORD LANE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction with Swift Point to the junction with Valley Drive.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing and associated works, nightly between 19.00 and 06.00.

Order Commences: 11 November 2019 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 16 November 2019.

LITTLE LAWFORD LANE, LITTLE LAWFORD
