Notice of application for a transfer licence to abstract (take) water

Tarmac Trading Limited has applied to the Environment Agency for a licence.

The Environment Agency is giving notice of this application (in accordance with Section 37 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and Regulation 6 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006.

The application is for a transfer licence to abstract water from the Shawell Sands underground strata between SP 53143 80691, SP 53475 80657, SP 53256 79970 and SP 52891 80488 to transfer it to the Newton Brook at SP 539108 0060 without intervening use.

The application is to abstract water as follows:

- 57.6 cubic metres an hour • 1,382 cubic metres a day
- 504,576 cubic metres a year • Abstraction will take place all year round.

Further details are: The proposed water transfer licence is for the purpose of dewatering in an extension area of an existing quarry operation, located in the Avon (Warwickshire Upper) catchment in the Warwickshire Avon Abstraction Licensing Strategy area.
