

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -
SECTION 14(1)(a)**

**THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1)
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Highways England Company Limited
(Company No. 9346363) intends to make
an order on the M6 Motorway, at Rugby,
in the County of Warwickshire, to allow the
creation of entrance/exit roads for a new
service station to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to, at
different times, -

1. impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit
on –
 - a) the southbound carriageway of the
M6 from a point 500 metres west of
the tip of the nosing at its junction
with the exit slip road at Junction 1,
to a point 144 metres east of that
tip of the nosing;
 - b) a length of the M6 northbound
exit slip road at Junction 1, from a
point 300 metres west of the tip of
the nosing at its junction with the
northbound carriageway of the M6,
to its roundabout junction with the
A426 near Cosford (M6 Junction 1
Roundabout); and
 - c) a length of the M6 southbound exit
slip road at Junction 1, from the tip
of the nosing at its junction with the
southbound carriageway of the M6,
to its junction with the M6 Junction
1 Roundabout;
2. close the exit slip roads leading from
the northbound and southbound
carriageways of the M6 at Junction 1.

The work is expected to start on
Monday 16 March 2020 and continue for
approximately six months. The slip road
closures will be carried out overnight
between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours
from Monday 30 March 2020. The speed
restrictions will be in operation from 20:00
hours on Monday 16 March 2020 and
will continue for 24 hours per day for the
duration of the works. The Order will come
into force on Friday 13 March 2020.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and
rescue authority or ambulance purposes
will be exempt from the speed restrictions
and closures. Vehicles being used for
special forces purposes will be exempt
from the speed restrictions, and vehicles
being used in connection with the work
and for winter maintenance purposes will
be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes using the M6, M69, A5,
A428, A426 and the M1 will be signed.
