ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

DEERINGS ROAD, FEATHERBED LANE & HOSKYN CLOSE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic as indicated by signage.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00hrs-17.00hrs weekdays only.

Order Commences: 20 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: A428, High Street, Deerings Road, School Street, The Kent and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

MILL ROAD, BUTLERS LEAP

Order Effect: Road Closure, between points approximately 20 metres either side of the railway bridge, to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To facilitate a safety examination of the bridge structure, overnight 21.00hrs-04.00hrs.

Order Commences: 2 August 2020 for 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 03 August 2020.

Access & Diversion: Murray Road, Whitehall Road, Clifton Road, Butlers Leap, Mill Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
