ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CATTHORPE ROAD/RUGBY ROAD, CATTHORPE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Watling Street eastwards for approximately 175 metres.

Reason for Order: To facilitate underground BT Openreach works.

Order Commences: 27 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 31 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Rugby road, Main St, Shawell Lane, A5.

HILL STREET & DUKE STREET, RUGBY

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:

1. Hill Street closed from its junction with Newbold Road to a point outside property number 2.

2. Duke Street closed from its junction with Newbold Road to a point outside property number 2.

Reason for Order: To facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 20 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 28 August 2020.

1. Hill Street, Dale Street, St John Street, Newbold Road and vice versa.

2. King Street, Hill Street, Dale Street, St John Street, Newbold Road and vice versa.

GAS STREET, RUGBY

Order Commences: 12 August 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 12 August 2020.
